GOAL: This week we look at the lives of Abraham and Sarah and how they waited on God.

GET GOING:

1. Would you describe yourself as a patient person? Why or why not? Who is the most patient person you know?

2. This weekend, Pastor Ron shared several reasons to wait on God. Which of these do you find most compelling and why? Can you think of any other reasons to wait on God?

3. Do you tend to get ahead of God and establish your own plans while waiting on Him? Or, do you tend to wait until you discern God's leading?

BONUS THOUGHT:

Abraham and Sarah probably lived around 2,000 BC. This shows that the biblical principles from 2,000 years before Jesus walked the earth are the same 2,000 years after Him as well.

KEEP GROWING

4. Read Hebrews 11:8-12. Thousands of years after Genesis, Abraham and Sarah are remembered by the author of Hebrews for the kind of faith they had.

- How do you see their faithfulness to wait on God in this passage?

- What blessings did Abraham and Sarah receive because they waited on God?

- What can you learn from the lives of Abraham and Sarah, both from their story in Genesis and what we read here in Hebrews?

5. Just like Abraham and Sarah, we are all waiting on God for something. What are you waiting on God for? What is God teaching you as you wait?

BONUS CHALLENGE:

Meet with God each day
