GOAL: God wants us to be faithful to Him, even if we've turned away. Just like Peter, we can also have comebacks.

GET GOING:

1. What's your favorite comeback story? Have you ever had a comeback moment in your life?

2. This weekend Pastor Ron shared 5 "D"s of Discipleship Departure. Have you ever wrestled with any of these? How did you overcome? What would you say to someone else who is wrestling with the same thing?

3. Just as Peter dropped his net to follow Jesus, there are "nets" in our lives that we need to drop. What "net" do you need to drop to experience God's blessing?

BONUS THOUGHT:

Peter was instrumental in starting the Church after Jesus ascended into Heaven. We're here today in large part because of Peter's comeback and faithfulness to Jesus.

KEEP GROWING

4. Read the following passages in Luke: 7:36-50, 8:43-48, 10:38-42, 17:11-19. These are all stories of people who knelt down before Jesus.

- Each person knelt before Jesus for different reasons. What were they?

- Which story do you identify with the most and why?

- For what reason do you need to kneel before God today?

5. This weekend we learned that my biggest failure is God's greatest opportunity. What might that be in your life? What is God calling you to do in response to this message?
