GET GOING:

1. Is there a situation in your life right now that seems impossible?
2. Review the “5 Transformational Truths of the Gospel.” Which have you come to know and embrace? Which one, if any, is hard for you to believe?
 - Jesus meets me as I am.
 - Jesus leads me to what is best.
 - Jesus saves me from myself.
 - Jesus surrounds me with His followers.
 - Jesus empowers me to do His Will.
3. As we learned this weekend, Jesus meets us where we’re at, and our spiritual journey is full of ups and downs. Have you ever had a time when you felt too far from God? What was that like?
4. Review the “4 Personal and Biblical Callings of God” in a person’s life. These are for every believer, so have you experienced any of these? Which one is God calling you to respond to right now?
 - God’s Call of Salvation (1 Timothy 2:4)
 - God’s Call of Sanctification (1 Thessalonians 4:3)
 - God’s Call of Separation (1 John 2:15)
 - God’s Call of Permeation (Matthew 5:13-14)

KEEP GROWING:

5. Have you ever seen God do the impossible in your life or in the life of someone close to you? What was that like, and how do you know only God could have done that?



6. Just as God placed a vision and calling on Saul's (Paul's) life, what's the vision and calling God has placed on your life?

7. In the Old Testament, the Exodus was the Israelites' gospel story; God saved His people by delivering them out of slavery and bringing them into the Promised Land. While there is a lot to this story, read Exodus 13:17-14:31. What principles from this weekend's message do you see in this passage? (i.e. God meets them where they are, God leads them to what is best, etc.) Where do you see these principles in the passage?

8. Finally, Jesus surrounds us with His followers. Is this true in your life right now? Are you in a small group? Who in your life is walking alongside you on your faith journey?

Bonus Challenge: Take time this week to read more of the Exodus story in Exodus 1-14. As we learned this week that anything is possible with God, note how you see God work the impossible in this great Old Testament story.

Memory Verse: *"So the church throughout all Judea and Galilee and Samaria had peace and was being built up. And walking in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit, it multiplied" (Acts 9:31).*
