What I Learned

- We are all uniquely designed. God made us all on purpose, which means there

- Psalm 139 is a special song that King David wrote to celebrate how God made him wonderful and remarkable and how God knew everything about King David.
- God is the great creator and designer of everything in the Universe. Each and everything is made exactly the way God wants it. God made us on purpose and for a purpose.
- God created us all to have a relationship with Him!

Get Talking

- God didn't make mistakes when He made us—He made masterpieces! Take 1
 day this week to ask these 2 questions and spend 3 minutes talking about
 them:
- What is special about you? What do you think God would say is special about you?
- What are some ways you can remember and celebrate that God made you on purpose?

Go Deeper

Read: Psalm 139. God made us on purpose. We are not an accident. We are remarkable and special to God because He made us.

- Play dough can help us remember that God made each and every one of us on purpose. What are some things you like about how God made you?
- We are wondrously made by God, which means every one of us is special and unique because God made us. When we believe this, how can it change how we see ourselves and others?

Now What?

Talk to God: One of the purposes God made you for is to praise Him, which means we can talk about how great He is! Pray by talking to God and thanking Him for making us on purpose.

• Thank You, God, for making us on purpose. You have made us each different, unique, and remarkable. Thank You for sending Jesus so we can have a relationship with You and know the truth about who You are and who You made us to be. Help us to celebrate how You made us. Work through us to help others see the truth of who You are and how you made them. Amen.
