

GOD IS FAITHFUL WHEN I AM CONFUSED January 26, 2025 // 2 Kings 6:8-23

What I Learned

- We learned that God is faithful. In 2 Kings 6:8-23, a prophet named Elisha and his servant found themselves in a tough situation when an enemy army surrounded them.
- Elisha's servant was worried and anxious, but Elisha knew God was faithful and would take care of them. Elisha prayed for the servant to see what was really happening, and God helped the servant see that a larger, heavenly army surrounded the physical army.
- We understand that God is faithful, and He always cares for us.

Get Talking

God is faithful when we are confused, and we can always turn to Him and ask Him for help.

- This week, take 1 day to ask these 2 questions and spend 3 minutes talking about them:
 - When do you feel confused or unsure of what's going on around you?
 - How can remember that God is faithful help in those situations?

Go Deeper

Read 2 Kings 6:16-17. Faithful means loyal, trustworthy, and dependable. When we say that God is faithful, that means that we can count on Him no matter what.

- Have you ever tried to build something without directions? Why do you think that could be confusing?
- Do you ever feel afraid or confused? How can this story help you the next time you feel that way?
- What are some things in our world that don't make sense or can leave us feeling confused? How can we remember that God is faithful when we're feeling confused?

Now What?

Talk with God. We can be secure in God! If we are ever confused or questioning things around us, we can turn to God trust Him. He is loyal, dependable, and everything He says is true. Take time to thank Him for this.

 God, thank You for being here for us. Thank You for giving us Your Word so that when life gets confusing or we find ourselves questioning things, we know where to find the answer. Help us to trust that You are faithful and good. Amen.

Memory Verse

Psalm 16:8
