What I Learned

- This weekend, we learned that we can talk with God. In Genesis 18 and 21:1-17, Abraham (who was also called Abram) had three special visitors.
- When Abraham talked with these visitors, God told Abraham that he would soon have a son, even in his old age. Abraham was able to talk with God and know that God is trustworthy and faithful.
- We know that we can talk with God, and as we do, we get to know Him more.

Get Talking

- No matter where we are or what is going on, we can talk with God and know that He listens, and He cares.
- This week, take 1 day to ask these 2 questions and spend 3 minutes talking about them:
 - Who are people you enjoy talking with, and what do you like to talk about?
 - What are things you can talk about with God?

Go Deeper

Read: Genesis 18. God, and we can talk with God. We can know God by having conversations with Him when we pray.

- God promised Abraham and Sarah that they would have a son, and God kept His promise. How can this help us when we talk with God?
- Sin broke our relationship with God, but God sent Jesus to rescue us from sin and make a way that we can have a relationship with God—one where we can talk with Him and know He listens, and He leads us. When you pray and talk to God, what are some things you can talk with Him about?

Now What?

Talk with God. We can be on vacation and talk to God. We can be in school and talk to God. He is always available. We know God listens when we talk to Him, just like He listened to Abraham. Take time to pray and thank Him for always listening to us.
